## PEEKTABLELAMP

### About

The Swedish designer Jonas Wagell initially designed the Peek lamp as a floor lamp to accompany a sofa he did a few years ago. The design is simplistic, humble and somewhat quirky. He explains, "I needed a lamp which was small and humble and simply "popped up" where you needed some light. The Peek lamp has a heavy base with a long slender stem and a touch-sensitive shade.

### Design

The Swedish architect and designer, Jonas Wagell, was born in 1973. Though Wagell's studio is based in downtown Stockholm, his collaborative relations stretch as far as China and North America. His work has become known for its simplistic playfulness, representing clever compact living. Jonas Wagell is a professional graphic designer who is also skilled within marketing, product design and architecture. He has attended schools such as Konstfack, Beckmans and Berghs in Stockholm and Parsons in New York City.

### Features and benefits

The shape and silhouette of the Peek table lamp is the same as the floor lamp – only the proportions have shrunk. Use the lamp as a reading light, as your new best friend on your desk or as the last thing you see before you close your eyes at night. The base has a concave top creating a bowl for essential stationary, earplugs, jewelry or other small items, and the tip of the stem functions as a dimmer.
